

Discover one of Africa's finest wildlife destinations

Nestled within a lush teak forest, this pristine wilderness estate offers exceptional wildlife sightings and the perfect base from which to explore Hwange National Park. Discover profound comfort in the luxurious accommodations, along with raised walkways and decks providing views across waterholes where elephant, buffalo, hyena, giraffe, zebra, kudu, waterbuck, impala, sable and the big cats come to drink. Roan, eland, cheetah, leopard and painted dogs are also common here, although sightings are rare. For birders, Gwango is a spectacular setting, attracting a large number of bird species. With Hwange National Park close by and so much to see, plan on spending a fair amount of time here.



Tree Top Villas (2 villas, 2 guests per villa)

Spacious double story thatched villas with upstairs entry. Luxury en-suite bathrooms include stone-cased bathtubs and oversized showers. Each villa is a secluded haven offering breath-taking views of waterholes from private raised decks and walkways.

Forest Chalets (3 chalets, 2 guests per chalet)

Charming single level thatched chalets with en suite bathrooms with showers, rustic furnishings and added comforts.

The Stone House is our grand main building constructed with magnificent stone pillars and an impressive arched stone entry.
